## Rialacha na Feise - Feis Rules

1. Entries will only be accepted from dancing teachers currently registered with An Coimisiún le Gaelacha for the years 2012/2013.
2. Age will be taken on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2013 (Whatever age you turn in 2013, you dance under that age, e.g. your date of birth is 16<sup>th</sup> April 2002, you dance Under 11 all year long).
3. All levels are open to all regions.
4. Dancers should only enter 1 grade per dance.
5. If a beginner competition has 6 competitors or more, the first 2 places advance to the next grade regardless of ties. If a beginner competition has 11 competitors or more, the first 3 places advance to the next grade regardless of ties (RTME ruling, Sept. 2007).
6. If a Primary competition has 6 or more dancers, the first place advances to the next grade, If a Primary competition has 11 competitors or more, the first 2 places advance to the next grade regardless of ties (RTME ruling, Jun. 2011).
7. **Intermediate Grade competitions** are open to all dancers who have not previously won first prize for that particular dance in Intermediate or Open Grade under the same or higher age limits.
8. Traditional Set Dance competitions are a choice out of 6 traditional, St. Patrick's Day, Blackbird, Job of Journeywork, Garden of Daisies, King of the Fairies and Jockey to the Fair. If you win a first place in any traditional set dance competition you move on the next level in all 6 traditional.
9. Where there are five dancers or less for Beginner, Primary and Intermediate competitions, the results will not affect their grading.
10. The Feis organizers will use 40 bars for 2-hands and 3-hands and lead, body and the first figure for 4-hands and 8-hands.
11. Team dances(four hands and upward)must be performed in accordance with the An Coimisiún handbook "Ar Rinci Foirne".
12. Within the limits specified in the Rules of An Coimisiún the organizers may at their discretion cancel or mixed competitions with insufficient entries.
13. Competitors must be in costume and ready to dance 30 minutes before their competitions are scheduled to start.
14. No refunds will be made.
15. Music will be played at the recognized Mainland European speeds.

16. Objections must be lodged in writing within one hour of the announcement of there sultofa competition accompanied by a fee of \$25.00 USD.
17. The use of video and/or digital cameras in the hall is not permitted,exception beginner & Primary competitions (CRLG Ruling Dec.2011).
18. Feis organizers cannot accept any liability for injuries sustained or for the loss of,or damage to property or belongings which may occur during the Feis.
19. The adjudicator's decision is final.
20. The lodgement of an entry will be taken to mean that a teacher and their pupils understand these rules and undertake to abide by them.
21. EnPointe/blockwork is not permitted for dancers up to and including the Under12 age group.
22. Make up will not be permitted for any dancer in the first two grades up to and including the Under 12 age group worldwide.
23. The dress code in accordance with An Coimisiun rules will be strictly observed i.e.forthe sake of modesty, and in the interest of safety to young people dancers will not be permitted to walk around the Feis scantily dressed.
24. This Feis is open to persons who are registered as teachers (in any category) with An Coimisuin and to registered Ceili Clubs.
